July 11, 2018

Meeting called to order at 5:12 pm by Mayor Holm. All members present. Also present is Kerry Babcock.

Motion to approve minutes as read by Jean Kiminski, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chris Volk. All approved

Treasurers report has \$146,631.30 in all accounts with \$127,278.78 in the general fund.

Motion to approve treasurers report as read by Jean Kiminski 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lisa Kuhlman. All approved

Motion to pay bills by Jean Kiminski, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lisa Kuhlman. All approved.

Kerry requested that the minutes be posted on the website, clerk stated that most are ready to upload tonight. Discussed that address cannot be changed on the road due to elections until August 14<sup>th</sup>.

Rick picked up a 16 gallon broadcast sprayer and roundup at Northern Hydraulics for a cheaper price than what was being looked at at the last meeting.

Dirt will be brought to the cemetery by Jim Bonk.

Chris attended the Kettle River Township meeting and reports that the culvert on Long Lake Rd. by Patterson's needs to be replaced, this was done before our city meeting. Culvert was plugged in the middle of the road. Chris told them to go ahead and supply us with the bill. Boundary street was talked about with discussion of cutting hills down and filling in where needed. This project will have to be engineered, but are looking at grants and other funding involvement. Discussed widening the road, which will involve the dnr, due to lowlands. Rarick was late at the meeting and is going to try to help with funding if possible. Chris also informed them that we do not have the budget to resurface roads as we just did our roads and budget is tight.

Motion to buy a new all in one printer by Chris Volk 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lisa Kuhlman, all approved.

The donated stove will probably be installed in August.

The Venture Crew 187 of Askov will be at the ball field on Saturday the 14<sup>th</sup> to paint/stain the bleachers and benches.

Lions club donated \$1000.00 to the city for whatever is needed.

Lions sign on the backstop is missing.

Rick meeting Aquarius next week for the water system check up.

NNO- August 7<sup>th</sup> at 6pm-8pm- plans are coming together, our turnout is low, so we are working to try to increase that. Amy taking care of food pickup enough for 50 people.

Elections- still in need of judges, we currently have 2 judges.

Lawns- there have been a few complaints about long lawns. Currently we do not have an ordinance. Rick will go and talk to them about getting it mowed. If this does not help, we will have to talk about an ordinance.

Air BNB- we currently do not have that requirement for a permit.
