

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-6

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE AMERICAN TELEPHONE COMPANIES, THE CITY OF
RUTLEDGE, MN

The City Council of the City of Rutledge does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the American Telephone and Telegraph Company of Minnesota, its successors and assigns be and same is hereby granted the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain lines of telephone and telegraph upon, along and under the highways of the City of Rutledge, County of Pine and State of Minnesota, upon the following terms and conditions.

Section II. All poles shall be erected under the supervision of the Commissioner of Highways of said City, and all streets or sidewalks that may be disturbed or damaged in the constructing, maintaining or repairing of said lines shall be promptly replaced and repaired by the said company at its own expense.

Section III. The said Company shall be subject to all ordinances now in force or that may be hereafter passed relative to the use of the public highways of said City.

Section IV. In consideration of the rights and privileges herein granted, said Company shall provide free of cost to said City one tin form cross-arm to be attached to the top of all poles erected under the provisions of this ordinance for the police and fire alarm telegraph system of said City.

Section V. Nothing in this ordinance contained shall be construed to grant to said Company and exclusive right, and the said City Council hereby reserves the right to grant a like consent to any other telephone or telegraph Company for like purposes.

Section VI.- This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication.
