Treasurer's report- \$180,776.52 in all funds with the general fund having \$160,989.27.

Mr. Davis outbid the credit union at the Sheriff's auction on the Pince property. Tim will talk to Mr. Davis about the situation.

The street light by the hair shop is overpowering after dark.

Fire extinguishers need to be updated. Jeff will work on this.

Shawn Eckermann is with the Willow River fire department. He is coming to the city with some concerns. Essential is taking over for Mercy and many of the 1st responders are changing. They may not be familiar with the towns and their people. Many houses in town do not have house numbers on them or even on a mailbox. Discussion of the numbers being posted on houses, garages, mailboxes and illuminated to make it easier for 1st responders to find. He also notified the city that the lock box codes will be changed. In the community center is a medical bag and AED unit, he check them and the pads are expired. The fire department will take care of replacing them.

Janel Orth has a client that would like to make an offer on the lots across from the bar. \$25,000 cash, commission and admin fees would be waived. Estimated cash takeaway would be \$24,500.
